## **Middle School Model**

- Each class has a homeroom teacher.

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## **MIDDLE SCHOOL CURRICULUM**

### **Bible**

All middle school students take Bible class. Mrs. Ramage teaches Bible for the 6<sup>th</sup> grade students and Mrs. Mason teaches Bible for the 7<sup>th</sup> & Mr. Stewart for 8<sup>th</sup> grade students.

### **Language Arts**

The middle school language arts curriculum is designed to develop, strong, independent thinkers, readers, and writers, using writing and grammar resources, fluency building exercises, SAT prep. vocabulary, usage and mechanics skills practice, and other reference materials. Students continue to develop strong writing skills through a range of writing activities including expository, persuasive, fictional and informational assignments. Middle school students take two separate language arts courses: 1) Grammar & Writing and 2) Literature. The literature reading list is attached.

### **Math**

The math curriculum progresses from math concepts and computation to Pre-Algebra to Algebra 1. As a result, all students will complete a high school level course while in eighth grade. Throughout the math curriculum, emphasis is placed on basic computation skills, problem solving, and attention to details.

### **Science**

The science curriculum focuses on general science in sixth and seventh grade and physical science in eighth. The curriculum is taught from a distinctively Christian perspective, uses Christian publishers, and highlights our glorious Creator. The sixth grade students complete the ACSI curriculum, which we use in grades 1-6. Seventh and eighth grade students use Apologia textbooks. Students learn scientific reasoning and the scientific method, and they complete an in depth science fair project each year.

### **Social Studies/History**

The social studies curriculum focuses on world geography (6<sup>th</sup>), world history (7<sup>th</sup>), and Georgia and United States history (8<sup>th</sup>). The curriculum highlights the key regions of our world, important events throughout history, and key leaders God has used throughout history.

### **Spanish**

The Spanish curriculum is designed to be an introduction to the Spanish language in 6<sup>th</sup> grade with an emphasis on vocabulary building. 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Spanish focuses on verb conjugation and grammar. 8<sup>th</sup> Grade students have the opportunity to test out of Spanish 1 at Glynn Academy prior to entry in to high school.

### **Electives**

Students are given the chance to choose between elective courses in art, music, and technology. Elective courses are one semester and meet twice a week.

### **Physical Education**

The physical education program helps students develop their athletic skills, learn game skills, and grow in their understanding of honoring God in sports competitions.
